#### **Provincial Diploma/PAT Exam Update**

In response to feedback from students, parents and education partners about stress and anxiety around academic achievement, Alberta's government will temporarily change the weighting of diploma exams to 10% from 30% for the 2021/22 school year. This will help ensure provincial standards are maintained while taking into account the learning disruptions that have occurred since March 2020. The weighting of diploma exams will return to 30%, effective September 1, 2022. More information is posted online.

Provincial Achievement Tests (PAT) will continue this school year, consistent with the 2021/22 school plan and as they would in any other school year.
