WHAT IS THE LEADERS OF TOMORROW AWARDS PROGRAM?

The *Leaders of Tomorrow* Awards Program recognizes youth who have made outstanding contributions to their community through leadership and/or volunteerism.

NOMINATION CRITERIA:

A *Leaders of Tomorrow* nominee:

- Exhibits dedication and commitment in any field of leadership work (including, but not limited to, school, community, athletics and fine arts)
- Inspires the spirit of volunteerism in others
- Is a positive role model

Each criteria above (leadership, volunteering, and a positive role model) is equally weighted.

NOMINATION CATEGORIES:

(Nominees can be nominated more than once in each category, but can only win once in each category)

- ELEMENTARY (Kindergarten Grade 6)
- JUNIOR (Grade 7 Grade 9)
- SENIOR (Grade 10 Grade 12)

AWARDS CEREMONY:

The 23nd Annual *Leaders of Tomorrow* Awards Program proudly recognizes all of our nominees. A celebration event will be held on:

A formal invitation will be sent to all nominees in March. We ask that you please mark this date on your calendar. This year's theme of the Awards Ceremony is "Carry the Torch".

Select an individual whom you feel is worthy of nomination and complete the		
Nomination Package. (The nominee can be nominated more than once in each category,		
but can only win once in each category. The nominee cannot be nominated by her or his		
parent.)		

- ☐ The Elementary Category Nomination Package must include:
 - Nominee Profile completed by the nominee.
 - A letter of reference by the nominator.
- ☐ The Junior & Senior Categories Nomination Package must include:
 - Nominee Profile completed by the nominee.
 - A letter of reference by the nominator.
 - An additional letter of reference/support from a member of the community (i.e. priest/minister, 4-H leader, coach, teacher, etc.) that is no more than 200 words in length. The letter cannot be written by a family member.
 - Letters must include name, address, phone number and e-mail.

All Categories:

Include ONE current picture (1 ½" x 2 ½" or 4 cm x 6 cm) of the nominee with	
nominee's name printed on the back of the picture.	
Include completed F.O.I.P. (Freedom of Information and Privacy) Consent section.	
Ensure all sections of the nomination form are completed.	
Submit completed nomination package upon receipt of all information before Thursday	
February 28, 2019.	
Attend the celebration where the award winners will be announced.
