ALEXANDER RUTHERFORD SCHOLARSHIPS

The Alexander Rutherford Scholarship (the Rutherford) was named in honour of Alexander Rutherford, Alberta's first Premier. The Rutherford recognizes and rewards academic achievement in senior high school to encourage students to pursue post-secondary studies. Apply for all three years in the year you plan to attend post secondary. There are no application deadlines.

Student Aid Alberta recommends students apply when your official high school transcripts are available & you have completed any high school upgrading credit courses you are taking - because you can only apply once - and you will want to submit your highest marks. Note: Your high school upgrading credit courses must appear on an official Alberta High School Transcript of Achievement. Apply in the year that you are planning on attending full-time post-secondary studies.
