It's grad week at PSC!! Here's an update of what's happening around our school!

Graduation 2023 Update & Schedule: Here is the list of our "Grad Week" activities, and information about the weekend!

Monday, **May 29** - Grad T-Shirt signing day! All grads were given a PSC Graduation shirt and were able to have their grad class sign their shirts as a keepsake!

Tuesday, May 30 - Our grads are dressing like their future selves. The theme is "me in 10 years"

Wednesday, May 31 - Grads are sticking to the dress up themes and wearing "tight and bright" clothes.

Thursday, June 1 - It is the Ponoka Grad Parade! We want to thank the Town of Ponoka for allowing this to take place. All graduating parade participants need to be at the arena parking lot where we will line up, get organized and start our parade. This is to celebrate all of our Ponoka graduates from multiple schools.

- Town of Ponoka is hosting the 3rd Annual Ponoka Graduate Parade
- All Ponoka Graduates Welcome, you may have a non graduate driving, but other than that, this is graduates only.
- We encourage graduates to wear their grad apparel, or nice clothes (not mandatory)
- Please remember you are representing yourselves, your family, and your school.
- You may enter with a float, car, horse, bicycle etc.
- Staging at the arena Thursday, June 1st between 5:30pm 6:00pm
- Parade begins at 6:30 pm (follows the Ponoka Stampede Parade route)

Friday, June 2 - Grad march / walkthrough - We will have all of our PSC graduates dress in their caps / gowns (the school has them ready to go) and we will walk through our PSC halls, to our Wolfcreek Central Office and through their building, through Centennial Park, through the Elementary School and will end at the arena. Please wear comfortable shoes to do the walk in

and bring a water bottle. Everyone will line the hallways as we go through their buildings to celebrate the graduation class. At the arena we will walk the students through the ceremony process to help settle any confusion.

- Students only
- At approximately 12:40 pm all graduates need to be in the activity centre
- Students will be given a grad gown and caps (if you beaded your cap, bring it). Gowns and caps will be left at the arena to be worn the next day for convocation.
- All graduates will walk through PSC, through the Wolf Creek District Office, to the Ponoka Elementary School, through the PES and then to the Arena for rehearsal.
- At the Arena, students will do a rehearsal and group photo
- Any last minute decorating or jobs will be completed if required
- Wear comfortable walking shoes
- Males- wear a collared shirt, tie and pants
- Females wear a shirt that won't show under your gown
- PSC will provide buses to take students back to the school in time for buses to take those who need them back home.

Saturday, June 3 - This is THE BIG DAY!! Grad will start at 11:00 AM so we will need ALL graduates to be early at the arena to get ready (no later than 10:30 AM). The grad ceremony will take place on the curling rink side.

- Graduates arrive by 10:30 am
- Convocation (cap & gown formal ceremony) begins 11:00am Banquet:

The evening banquet will be Saturday evening as well. This is where the students wear their suits / dresses and get to run the evening.

- Doors open at 4:30 pm
- The Banquet begins with Grand March at 5:00 pm
- Program to follow with dance afterwards.


