Broncs World Tour: Our BWT had an amazing trip over Spring Break as they toured the Netherlands, Belgium, Germany, France, and Italy.

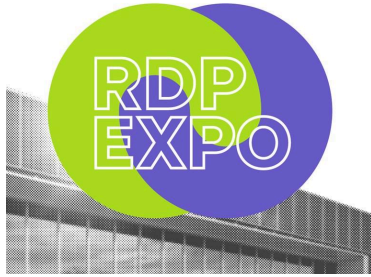

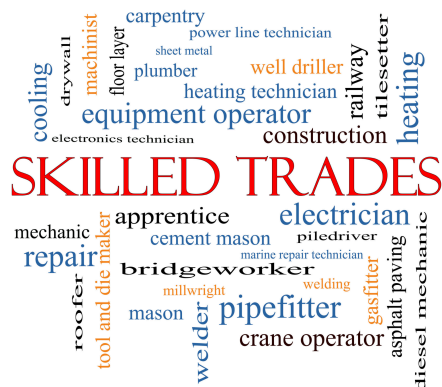

Who needs to register for Wolf Creek Bus Transportation for the 2024/25 school year?

- All urban (in town students - Ponoka & Lacombe).

- All students new to transportation
- All students who are moving to a new address.
- All Cross Boundary students must re-register every year.

Who does not need to register?

- Rural students who have not had a change in address or school location.

Unsure?

- If parents are not sure if they need to register, or are unsure which school they need to register at, they can reach out to transportation@wolfcreek.ab.ca.

- What do you need to do to register?

- Street address if urban, legal land description and complete 911 address if rural.

- Applications are submitted online through the Parent Portal or SchoolEngage.
