

The Ponoka Ag Society supports four \$750 scholarships a year to residents pursuing post-secondary.

Criteria:

- 1. Reside in the Town or County Ponoka East of the Crestomere School west boundary.
- 2. Between the ages of 17 and 21 as of December 1st.
- 3. Enrolled at a post-secondary in a trade, certificate, diploma, or degree program:
 - a) that is directly related to agriculture or
 - b) that the candidate can show will benefit future rural agricultural communities.
- 4. Documented active participation in their family, school, and community.
- 5. Demonstrated leadership in those activities.
- 6. Volunteered in the community. Volunteering with the Ponoka Ag Society would be a bonus! Do not hesitate to check out opportunities!
- ** Preference given to first time recipients.

Applicants must:

- 1. Submit a completed PAS Scholarship Application, including short personal essay outlining how your training will be of benefit to rural Alberta. See below.
- 2. Include your most recent up to-date record of academic achievement from your school or Alberta Education.

*Proof of payment for the program will be required before funds will be released to declared recipients.
