### **COUNTRY (RURAL) BUS STUDENTS**

Ponoka students who live in the country and are <u>new</u> to busing (i.e. kindergarten students or students changing schools)
OR have moved to a new rural location are required to register for transportation.

To register your full legal land description AND complete blue sign (911 address) are required on the application.

\*Unsure of which school your child should attend, please call us with your legal land description.

If you have moved you must notify the school of the address change PRIOR to registering for busing.

\*Cross Boundary students must re-apply each year by filling out the regular application and the cross boundary application. Please note that cross boundary fees will apply.
